Science Again Shows Landfill is in Managed State

BRIDGETON, MO (March 30, 2018) -- The Bridgeton Landfill team announced today the latest site data which further reinforce that the site remains in a managed state. The March 2018 report to State regulators involves over 5,000 data points collected during the month of February. The science provides further affirmation that the subsurface reaction remains isolated to a portion of the South Quarry. Analyzing landfill gas composition, surface settlement, wellhead temperatures, and subsurface temperatures, the report also demonstrates conditions in the Landfill's North Quarry remain stable.



For over four years, the Landfill team has submitted detailed monthly reports to State regulators. These submissions add to the volumes of publicly available data. The March 2018 report as well as past reports are available at: http://www.bridgetonlandfill.com/official-reports.
